BEFORE THE BUS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make sure you have everything (see list above) 2. Students will be in their warm-ups AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT IN MARCHING UNIFORM. 3. You cannot take off your warm-up jacket unless you have the show shirt on underneath. Don't lose your jacket. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bus line-up: Leaders, Seniors, Juniors, Sophomores, Freshmen 2. Stay before the clock.
BUS RIDES AND PIT STOPS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. From here on out you represent CHS. 2. ZERO tolerance on excessive PDA. You will be singled out and harshly punished for any excessive PDA. No exceptions. One couple can ruin it for every BOY and GIRL (hint, hint). 3. Stay with the group. Behave well. 4.
