

Talons meeting Monday October 1st 2007

7:02pm Meeting called to order by Teresa Cushnyr and the "Mission Statement" was read.

Minutes of last meeting reviewed by TC as well and they were approved as is.

Financial report read by Liz Cunningham and report is on file.

Script report read by Jeanne Allen and is on file.

Escript report read by Beth Lenau and is on file.

Teresa then took a few minutes and explained Script and Escript to all who were present. She mentioned all the benefits to the school as well as their individual child. Told them all how to use the program and how important it is to the Band. A few parents asked some questions and wrote notes, as they did not seem to be aware of all these programs and their benefits. Littlehawk Day: Teresa explained Little hawk day and Mr. Campos purposed the idea of a "Little hawk" shirt and should we cover the cost of their entry into the West High competition which is where we are holding Little hawk day on November 3rd. We will Barbeque around 3pm with the Talons buying the meat and buns and drinks and all the parents bringing a potluck meal. (more details for the potluck specifics to follow via email. We took a vote and decided to only charge \$10 (cost) for the Little hawk shirts and that the talons would pay the entry fee for each little hawk but not their families.

Pit Crew Volunteers needed: Teresa expressed the need and exactly what the pit crew does. We discussed the first upcoming competition and basically walked all the new parents through the day and how their assistance comes into play.

PACC: A parent went to the PACC meeting and got dates and applications for Mr. Campos. She then came to the meeting and participated as well as reviewed the dates.

Insurance: We have obtained Insurance for the entire year through Walter Mortenson insurance.

MIM lane closure: This has been secured with the city and paid for (Cindi has a permit)

Winter Drumline: Mr. Campos reported the cost is \$1000 already in the budget.
