- Auditions – the judges were very happy and the evening ran very smoothly.

### **IV. New Business**

- School Sign:
  - It was put to the floor for discussion for the band program to give a donation toward the new Centennial sign as a show of good faith to show the animosity between the groups has dissipated.

- Contract for Next year with show writer

  - Total cost will be \$3000

  - Mr. Campos to get a cost for fixing the new marimba. It was brought to floor that the handling of this equipment needs to be addresses. The loading of the equipment has been rough and needs to be more carefully done as well as making sure nothing is put on top of these instruments at any time.
  - Mr. Campos will look into getting a cost on padded covers.
  - Uniforms will have a parent committee to check out and in uniforms at every competition and home game.
