- **Mr. Campos' Report**
 - Band fees this year will be \$340.00 per student. How might we alleviate the cost without making any cuts? Sponsorships, candy sales, and in March a rummage sale – the discussion has been tabled to revisit at the next meeting. Newsletter to students regarding Band Camp will ask students to brainstorm fund raising ideas.
 - The Campos' baby is due around MIMs. Per Teresa Cushnyr – delegate someone to stand by – Mr. Campos will work on that, possibly Bob since he is the assistant director.
 - Spring Tour idea was discussed. Dates were either March –week after spring break or May– right after Spring Fling. It was discussed that students need to pay 1 week prior to departure. Cost per student was undetermined at this time. Mr. Campos is working with a travel agent to have students stay at Buffalo Bills/Primm. Students will travel to Las Vegas to visit UNLV and perform, dinner at Rainforest Café, watch a show – more to come. Group made a suggestion that behavioral problems during the school year should not be allowed to go to Spring Fling. **Mr. Campos to ask travel agent if deposit is non refundable and to have an approximate cost.**
